ArcView, ArcEditor, ArcGIS Desktop, and ArcInfo is for Windows NT, Windows 2000, and Windows XP. ArcInfo Workstation and other extensions are available for UNIX platforms.

ArcView and ArcEditor require registration numbers at the end of the installation process.

ArcGIS Desktop and ArcGIS ArcInfo and its extensions require a hardware device called a Sentinel Key and a unique registration file. To obtain a Sentinel Key and a registration file send this information about your computer to Keith Witherell:

Manufacturer, Model, Serial Number, Operating System, and Internet Host Name

The Sentinel Key is a hardware device that plugs into the printer or USB port of a server or workstation.

If ArcGIS licenses are distributed from a server, the Sentinel Key is for the server. Please supply the number of workstations that will use that server to obtain their license.

If ArcGIS is installed individually to a workstation, one Sentinel Key must be attached to each workstation, and each station must be registered individually.
