



Management Information Data Sheet #06-04 Summer, 2006 Enrollment Data

- Table 1** Enrollment for Summer, 2006, at 4932 students was a decrease of -67 from summer, 2005. This was a yearly decrease in student enrollment of -1.3%.
- Table 2** Summer enrollment decreased by -1.1% for females and -1.9% for males from last summer.
- Table 3** There was an increase of 0.4% in the number of credit hours taken by students this summer over Summer, 2005.
- Table 4** The proportion of students taking 3.0 credit hours during summer, 2006, decreased slightly from 48.65% to 46.76%. The proportion of students taking more than 3 credit hours increased by 2.1%.
- Table 5** While student enrollment for Summer, 2006 decreased, the average credit load per student increased by 6.0% to 5.1 credit hours.
- Table 6** There was a decrease in full time enrollments and a decrease in part-time enrollments this summer compared to summer, 2005. Full time decreased by -2.1%, while part time decreased by -1.2%. Part time enrollments comprised 85.2% of the total student body.
- Table 7** Both in-state and out-of-state enrollments were down from Summer, 2005, enrollments, in-state decreasing by -1.0%, while out-of-state decreased by -5.6%.
- Table 8** In state full-time equivalent student enrollments increased by 0.9% while out-of-state full-time equivalent students decreased by -3.7% compared to Summer, 2005.
- Table 9** The number of Maine residents decreased by 48 and now comprises 93.5% of total summer enrollments. Cumberland and York county residents accounted for 61.8% of the total in state enrollments, a -0.7% decrease in proportions from Summer, 2005. Foreign enrollments increased by 9 or 0.5% of total from summer, 2005.
- Table 10** All levels of degree students decreased this summer except Graduate and Baccalaureate which had an increase of 78 (9.1%) and 15 (0.6%), respectively. Total Non-Degree and Non-Degree Graduate & Law levels had the largest decreases of -143 (-8.0%) and -37 (-5.7%), respectively.
- Table 11** The largest increases in number of degree students by school or college in Summer, 2006, occurred in Education & Human Development at 68 (13.5%) and ITV at 24 (30.4%). The largest decreases occurred in Applied Science at -16 (-12.6%) and Arts & Sciences at -11 (-1.0%).
- Table 12** ITV experienced the largest percentage increase of students at 30.4% (24) and CEHD at 13.5% (68), for Summer 2006. The largest percentage decreases in student enrollments occurred in Law at -35.1% (-13) and Applied Science at -12.6% (-16).
