



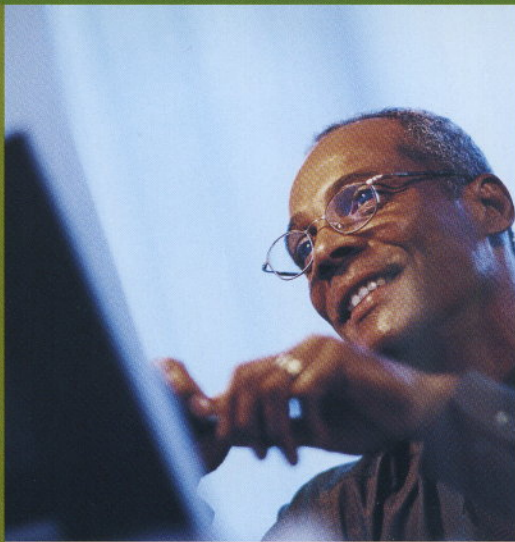
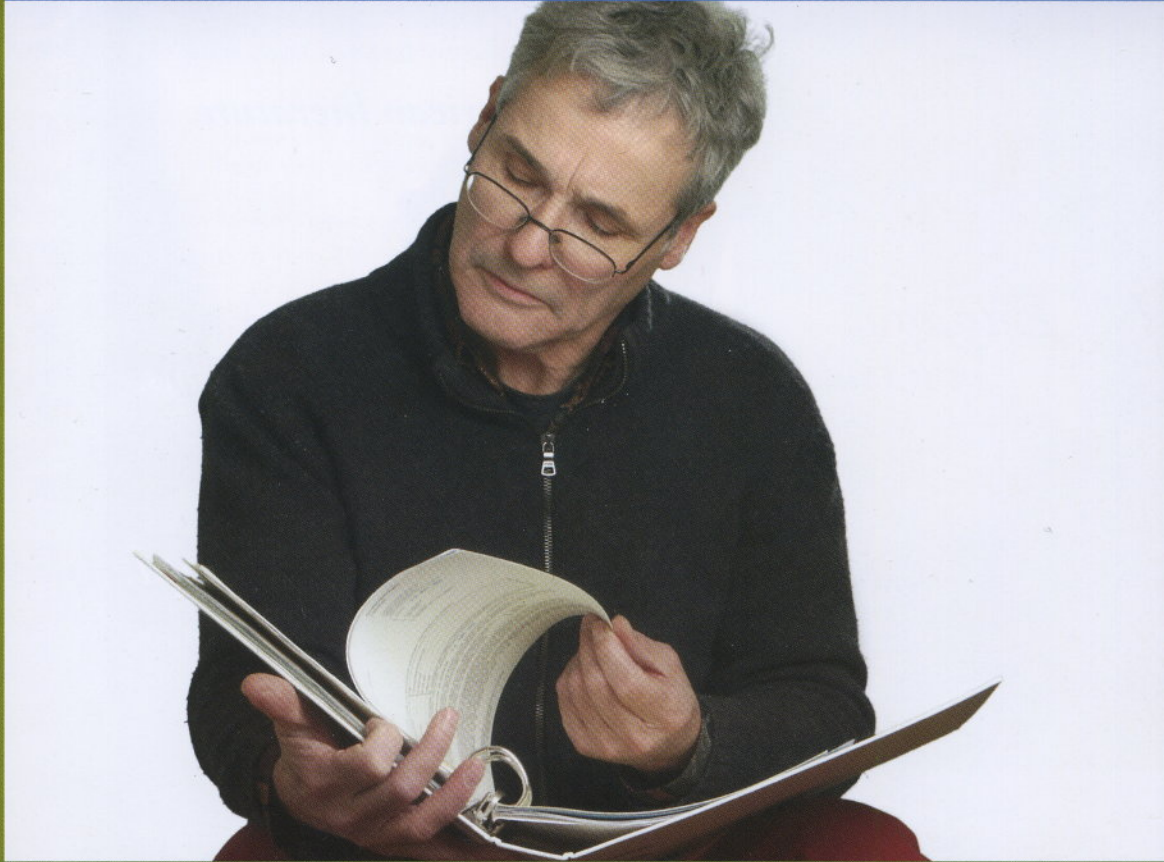



Each quarter ICL features more than twenty different programs.

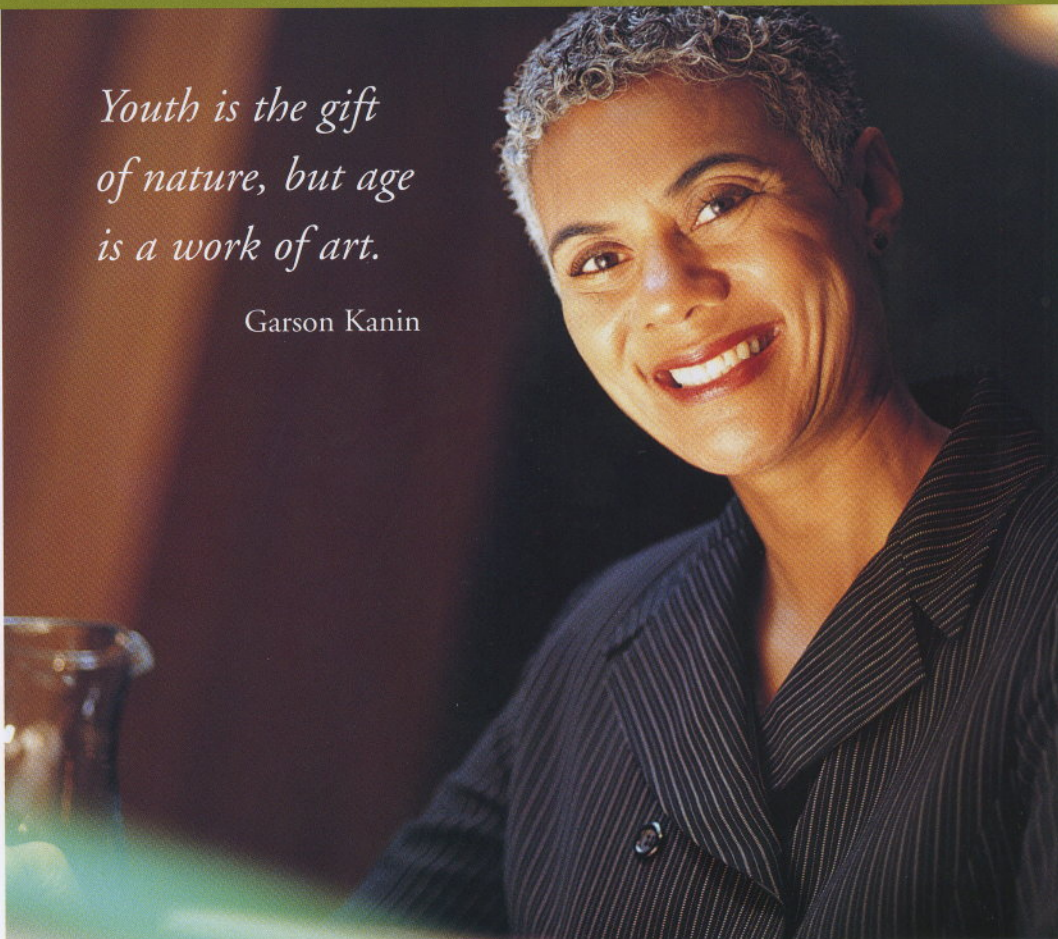
