

## **DIRECTIONS TO THE STONE HOUSE**

### **By car from the South (35 minutes from Portland):**

Follow Interstate 95 to Interstate 295 to Desert Road, Exit 20 (formerly exit 19) in Freeport. Turn right off the ramp, head straight into downtown Freeport. At town's center turn right onto Bow Street (opposite L.L. Bean). After approximately 2.5 miles, bear right onto Wolf Neck Road. Stay on Wolf Neck Road for 2.25 miles, passing the entrance to the State Park; continue to the very end of the road, the road is dirt in the State Park then returns to pavement. The road ends in our parking lot.

### **By car from the North (45 minutes from Augusta):**

Exit Interstate 295 at Freeport/Durham Exit 22 (formerly exit 20) in Freeport; turn right off the ramp towards Freeport; turn right on to Main St; turn left across from L.L. Bean onto Bow St. After approximately 2.5 miles, bear right onto Wolf Neck Road. Stay on Wolf Neck Road for 2.25 miles, passing the entrance to the State Park; continue to the very end of the road, the road is dirt in the State Park then returns to pavement. The road ends in our parking lot.

If there is not enough parking in the driveway, you may park your car by the large white barn prior to arriving to the house. **Please do not park along the roadway since it is privately held property and you will be asked to move your car. Residents living on the Neck may request that your car be towed at your expense if you park along the road.**

### **Directions to the Stone House from Main Street Freeport**

Left onto Route 1/Main Street. Bow Street is approximately a half mile, across from the L.L.Bean retail store. Turn onto Bow Street. Continue approximately 2.5 miles on Bow Street, which becomes Flying Point Road. Turn right onto Wolfe's Neck Road. Continue on Wolfe's Neck Road until you go through Wolfe's Neck Woods State Park. The Stone House entrance is about .5 mile past the park on your right. If there is not enough parking in the driveway, you may park your car by the large white barn prior to arriving to the house. Please do not park along the roadway since it is privately held property and you will be asked to move your car. Residents living on the Neck may request that your car be towed at your expense if you park along the road.
