- CHY 113 Principles of Chemistry I Credits: 3 (has math prerequisites)
- PSY 100 - Introduction to Psychology Credits: 3
- HRD 200 - Multicultural Human Development Credits: 3
- SPM 100* - Introduction to Exercise, Health, and Sport Sciences Credits: 3
* Only required for Health Science majors, not Nursing majors
- SOC 100 - Introduction to Sociology Credits: 3

- ENG 140 - Reading Literature Credits: 3
- THE 170 - Public Speaking Credits: 3
- MAT 120 - Introduction to Statistics Credits: 4 (requires math placement test)
