Important Notes:

In addition to using this guide, always discuss your curriculum plan with your Faculty Advisor!

- a. These courses are offered in **both** Fall and Spring semesters.
- b. Electives can be taken during any semester, and are often taken during the summer. The SSW offers graduate elective options every semester, including summer. Students can take up to 6 elective credits outside the SSW with prior approval from their Faculty Advisor.
- c. Students can enroll in *either* SWO651 *or* SWO603 for the Fall Semester of Year Two. Whichever course is not taken in the Fall Semester will be taken in the Spring Semester of Year Two.
- d. Students can complete a Graduate Thesis in lieu of two elective courses. Refer to the MSW Thesis Manual for more information and discuss this option with your Faculty Advisor.
