Examination

Examination-ASWB

\$60 to apply to take exam- per website for Maine

\$230 (Bachelor's and Master's) fee to take the exam

Content outlines

Provide test takers an outline of materials to expect on exams 170 questions (20 unscored pretest)

Taking the exam before graduation

ASWB requires all states to approve candidates prior to allowing them to take exam.

 You can take the exam with proof of degree (official transcript), or a letter from USM indicating your expected date of graduation and that you are in good standing. You would then submit the official transcript after passing the exam when you apply for licensure.

 Your licensure application <u>is not complete</u> until MSW degree is conferred and the official transcript from a CSWE accredited institution is submitted as proof

Licensure

I'm leaving Maine!

Moving now

Apply for licensure in that state, not here.

Moving Later

- Look at that state's site regarding <u>reciprocity</u>
 - o i.e. being able to use a Maine license to do practice in that state
- If no reciprocity, you will need to apply there

Licensure costs

Application:

- \$70 for licensure application
- \$21 Criminal history check

Renewal:

\$70 (up to 60 days before and 90 days after due date)

Continuing Education Units (CEUs)

25 hours every license cycle (2 years)

- Four of those MUST be in ethics
- Keep records of your CEUs

Must have had 12 hours of IPV

Part of USM curriculum

Bachelor's of Social Work-LSW

- BSW
- Completion of ASWB exam
- Must have a <u>consultation agreement</u> on record with the State for supervision
 - First 2-4 years of work

CANNOT ENGAGE IN PRIVATE PRACTICE

LSW Process

- A completed <u>Online Application</u> for Licensure
- Documentation of successful passage of the required <u>ASWB Bachelors examination</u>
- A copy of your official transcript of an earned Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) or Social Welfare degree from a CSWE accredited program
- A completed "<u>Agreement to Provide Consultation</u>" form, signed by a qualified consultant

LSW continued

If you also have other licenses (current or old) you must include them:

"Official license verifications for all professional licenses the applicant holds or has ever held, even if they are now expired. License verifications need to include the applicant's name, license number, license type, initial issue date, current expiration date and whether the license has ever been disciplined. Copies of professional licenses are **not** acceptable."

USM's degree is for "Advanced Social Work Practice"

Do NOT let the term "clinical" confuse you!!!

LMSW

Non-clinical

For those with an MSW NOT pursuing or needing to pursue clinical work

Process:

- Take Exam.
- Apply for license
- Official verification of all other licenses (ex.- CADC)

LMSW-cc

"...a clinical, master level, conditional license which requires an earned master's or doctoral of social work degree and a passing score on the ASWB Masters examination... may not engage in private practice."

Maine Board of Social Work Licensure

LMSW-cc

A "conditional license" indicates the MC licensee has entered an arrangement of consultation pursuant to Chapter 13 section 4.(1)(C) and may not practice social work without an active <u>consultation agreement</u> on record with the Board. If a consultation agreement ends, the MC must notify the Board and submit a new consultation agreement form for approval.

The consultant shall provide consultation pursuant to Chapter 13 Section 5.(1)(D) and provide a <u>Verification of Consultation</u> Form to the MC licensee when either the consultation requirement for LC licensure **has been completed**, or the consultation agreement has **ended**.

Consultation

Completion of 96 hours of consultation concurrent with 3200 hours of social work employment in a clinical setting.

Consultation is by, "licensed clinical social worker, certified social worker - independent practice, licensed clinical professional counselor, licensed marriage and family therapist, licensed psychologist, licensed psychiatrist, or similarly-credentialed licensee in any of the aforementioned professions from any state or country engaged as the consultant."

LMSW-cc

- Take and pass exam
- Obtain a supervisor "consultant"
- A completed <u>Agreement to Provide Consultation</u> form, signed by a qualified consultant
- A completed <u>Clinical Concentration Worksheet</u>
- Apply for licensure
