Policies, Course Progression, Grade Requirements

1. All courses marked with a * must be completed prior to beginning NUR 300/301/306/307/339. All Courses required for major must be completed with a C or better except for NUR Courses which require a C+ or better. Students must maintain a cumulative USM GPA ≥ 2.75 . For detail on this and all other policies please see the Undergraduate Catalog - Undergraduate Nursing Policies 2021-2022.
2. Students must maintain a Science GPA ≥ 2.67 in required nursing science courses. See 2021-2022 Undergraduate Catalog - Undergraduate Nursing Policies.
3. Core Curriculum Notes: The Socio-Cultural Analysis requirement is met by completing HRD 200 or SOC 100. Diversity requirement is met by completing both NUR 339 and 341 in the Nursing curriculum. The International requirement is met by completing both NUR 100 (and 200) and NUR356 in the Nursing curriculum. Ethical Inquiry requirement is met by completing NUR 100 (or 200), 306, 331, 325, 339, 341, 422, 425, 424, 470, NUR 321, and NUR 356 in the Nursing curriculum. Engaged Learning requirement will be met through a range of courses in the curriculum. WRI3 Requirement is met by completing NUR490
4. CHY 107 is recommended, but CHY 113 also accepted. If CHY 113, CHY 114 lab is not required for Nursing.
5. PSY 201, Psychological Statistics can be accepted in place of MAT 120.
6. NUR 100 can be replaced with NUR 200 for students with more than 60 credits completed if desired. NUR 100 or 200 must be completed prior to NUR 323/325.
7. CON 356 must be completed before or concurrently to NUR339
8. Pharmacology must be completed no more than 2 years prior to starting NUR 323/325.
9. The Clinical Health and Background Check Requirements must be completed prior to beginning NUR 306/307. For Fall sections of NUR 306/307 Health Requirements due June 1. For Spring sections of NUR 306/307 Health Requirements are due November 1.
