




# SUCCESSING AS A REMOTE LEARNER

## Modules in Brightspace

The "Succeeding as a Remote Learner" virtual series, created by USM's Learning Support team, is designed to help USM students navigate the demands, technologies, and opportunities of being a remote learner. As with learning anything in life, *it's what you DO that matters*. The modules in this series are filled with "doing", including how to engage in a course through Brightspace, collaborate with others via Zoom, prepare for the semester, practice effective learning strategies, and be academically successful. This entire experience aims to make your learning time and effort work for you, reducing stress and increasing the joy associated with learning.

# 1

To access the "Succeeding as a Remote Learner" modules in Brightspace, log in to Brightspace via your [MyUSM campus portal](#) or by going to [courses.maine.edu](#). Once in Brightspace, you will see the **Enter Modules** button under "Student Resources" on the on the right-hand side of the USM Brightspace landing page. Click on **Enter Modules**.

You will then be prompted to **Enroll** in the "Succeeding as a Remote Learner" course. (Note: You are not "enrolling" in an actual University course and there are no fees associated with enrolling in this course. Enrolling will simply give you access to the modules.) Once you have enrolled, select **Open Course**.

Once inside the course, click on the **Content** link in the blue Navbar to get started, or click on one of the module links listed for direct access. If you are on a mobile device, tap the menu button (three horizontal lines in the upper-left corner) and tap **Content**. The course will also be available in your My Courses widget.

As a USM student, you can elect to review specific components of the modules, or complete an entire module (or the entire series)! **Completing any module will award you a *Digital Badge*, with opportunities to earn multiple badges through this process.** To share your badge with others, simply follow the steps at the end of each module.
