Test Scoring Guide for the USM-Math Placement Test on Brightspace

Please see the Math Placement Test scores that are required to be placed in each of the following USM mathematics courses.

Students are required to start with Part 1, and then can move to Part 2 and Part 3 of the test if they want to enroll in a higher level mathematics course (Pre-Calculus or Calculus A).

Students majoring or plan to major in Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Economics (BA-Math Intensive Track), Engineering, Environmental Science, Mathematics, or Physics have upper level mathematics requirements in their major. Therefore, it is recommended that these students take all three parts of the Math Placement Test.
