

Fall 2018 Math Proficiency Policy: New SATM Scores vs Old SATM Scores

New SAT-Math Scores refers to SAT-M scores taken March 2016 or after:

- New SAT-M scores of 570 or higher (or ACT scores of 22 or above) meets the “math readiness” requirement.
 - Students can enroll in the MAT 105, MAT 108, or MAT 120 course. No Math Placement Test: Accuplacer Arithmetic/Elementary Algebra scores would be required.
 - Students can opt to take the College-Level Math Test for placement into MAT 140 or MAT 152. See Placement Score Rubric for cut-off scores.
- New SAT-M scores of 460-560 (or ACT scores of 18-21) allows students to enroll in MAT 101 without the Math Placement Test: Accuplacer Arithmetic/Elementary Algebra scores.
 - Students can opt to take the Math Placement Test: Accuplacer Arithmetic/Elementary Algebra for placement into MAT 105, MAT 108, or MAT 120. See Placement Score Rubric for cut-off scores.
- New SAT-M scores below 460 (or ACT scores below 18) requires students to take the Math Placement Test: Accuplacer Arithmetic/Elementary Algebra for the most appropriate course placement. See Placement Score Rubric for cut-off scores.

Old SAT-Math Scores refers to SAT-M scores taken prior to March 2016:

- Old SAT-M scores of 550 or higher (or ACT scores of 22 or above) meets the “math readiness” requirement.
 - Students can enroll in the MAT 105, MAT 108, or MAT 120 course. No Math Placement Test: Accuplacer Arithmetic/Elementary Algebra scores would be required.
 - Students can opt to take the College-Level Math Test for placement into MAT 140 or MAT 152. See Placement Score Rubric for cut-off scores.
- Old SAT-M scores of 420-540 (or ACT scores of 18-21) allows students to enroll in MAT 101 without the Math Placement Test: Accuplacer Arithmetic/Elementary Algebra scores.
 - Students can opt to take the Math Placement Test: Accuplacer Arithmetic/Elementary Algebra for placement into MAT 105, MAT 108, or MAT 120. See Placement Score Rubric for cut-off scores.
- Old SAT-M scores below 420 (or ACT scores below 18) requires students to take the Math Placement Test: Accuplacer Arithmetic/Elementary Algebra for the most appropriate course placement. See Placement Score Rubric for cut-off scores.
