- Student credit hours (SCH) are determined by the sum of the UM_UNT_TAK_PRG_RC field as determined by UMS.
- UMS defines a full time student as follows: (a) an undergraduate or law student taking 12 or more credits, or (b) a graduate student taking 6 or more credits in a given semester.
