Degree seeking is determined as a student flagged with a "Y" in the FA_ELIGIBILITY field as defined by UMS.

Full time/Part time are determined by the UM_ACAD_LOAD_RC field as defined by UMS.

Student credit hours (SCH) are determined by the sum of the UM_UNT_TAK_PRG_RC field as defined by UMS.

UMS defines a full time Undergraduate or Law student as taking 12 or more SCH (see above) in a given semester. A full time Graduate student is defined as taking 6 or more student credit hours in a given semester.
