Degree-Seeking Students - Fall GPAs to Spring (Term2) Retention Highlights:

- * The overall Fall GPA for all students was 2.93628
- * The retention rate of all students was 82.09% and had a Fall GPA of 3.03849
- * All First Year Students (Full and Part Time) had a Spring retention rate of 86.71% and had a Fall GPA of 2.8785
- * The Fall GPA of all First Year students was 2.744
- * Male dorm students had an 89.75 retention rate, the highest of all categories, and a Fall GPA of 2.7156
- * All Students age 18 - 24 had a retention rate of 84.92% and a Fall GPA of 2.9727
- * Commuter students had a retention rate of 80.10% and a Fall GPA of 3.0891
- * Female students 25 and older had the highest Fall GPAs in all categories with the highest Fall GPA in those returning Spring: 3.2978
- * Non-Returning Females 25 and older had an attrition rate of 21.42% and a Fall GPA of 2.7636

- * The overall Spring CUMGPA for all students enrolled Fall'16 returning Fall'17 was 3.0416
- * The overall retention rate of First Year Students was 67.2% and those returning students had a Spring CUMGPA of 3.0372
- * Female Dorm Students had the highest Year2 retention rate of 70.54% and had a Spring CUMGPA of 3.0992

FALL 2016 TERM2 (SPRING 2017) AND YEAR2 (FALL 2017) RETENTION AND GPA

Fall 2016 First Time First Year Cohort – Our first year first time cohort of 805 students had a fall 2016 GPA of 2.7.440. Those who returned to spring 2017 had a fall GPA of 2.8785 and a spring GPA of 2.7514. Of the first time first year cohort, **86.71% returned to spring 2017 and 67.2% returned to fall 2017**. The non-returners to spring 2017 had a fall GPA of 1.7557 and 1.49% of this cohort did not complete fall 2016.

Fall 2016 Degree Seeking Undergraduate Enrollments – In this report, we have broken continuing students into 3 groups: 1) **all** undergraduate degree seeking students; 2) undergraduate degree seeking students (**ages 18-24**); and 3) undergraduate degree seeking students (**ages > 24**). The 3rd group, the undergraduate degree seeking students (ages > 24): have the highest GPA for the fall 2016 (3.0781); have the highest GPA for the fall 2016 of those returning spring 2017 (3.1881); have the highest GPA for the spring 2017 (3.1300); have the lowest spring 2017 retention rate (76.07%) and the lowest fall 2017 (48.21%) retention rates and had the highest spring CUMGPA of 3.1401 out of all three groups. The highest retention rate to spring 2017 and fall 2017 was from the students that were between the ages of 18 and 24 (84.92%, 60.91% respectively). When looking at the non-returners to spring 2017, the group with the lowest fall GPA was the 2nd group, those between the ages of 18 and 24, at 2.2083.

Fall 2016 Dorm and Commuter Students - In the category of all dorm students or Gorham residents enrolled for fall 2016, there were 1,133 students whom had a fall 2016 GPA of 2.8012. Those who returned to spring 2017 had a fall GPA of 2.7841 and a spring GPA of 2.8050. Of this same group of dorm students, 89.32% returned to spring 2017 and 69.37% returned to fall 2017. Commuters had a spring 2017 retention rate of 80.10% and a fall 2017 retention rate of 53.41%. The non-returners to spring 2017 had a fall GPA of 2.4446 and 2.54% of our Commuter students did not complete fall 2016. Commuters that did return to fall 2017 had a CUMGPA in the spring of 3.0639.
