## LEWISTON AUBURN COLLEGE STUDENT PROFILE REPORT FALL 2018

This report focuses on any USM student who enrolled in a course at USM's Lewiston Auburn College Fall 2014 through Fall 2018. Any course with an Academic Org of USM Lewiston Auburn or a USM Dept of Lewiston Auburn is pulled for this summary report. The students are broken down in 3 different categories:

- Non degree;
- NonLAC matrics (matriculated in a degree program that is not LAC); and
- LAC matrics.

In this report, you will find summaries by:

- Headcount by category and major/plan (Pages 1-4);
- Enrollments by the students' category and major/plan (Pages 5-8);
- Enrollments and course credit hours generated by category (Pages 9-10).
- Enrollments and course credit hours generated by category and the course subjects (Pages 11-18); and

Continued this year, is the breakdown for LAC matrics and the subjects of the courses they are taking. Please note the \* regarding enrollments (butts in seats) in courses and how they are counted in the course subject summaries section.

### A FIRST LOOK AT LEWISTON AUBURN STUDENT PROFILE FALL 2018:

When looking at **Headcounts**:

- 57% of all students taking a course at LAC were non-LAC matrics.
- 43% of the students taking a course at LAC were LAC matrics. Only 4.7% of the students were non-degree.
- At the non-LAC matric undergraduate level, 25.1% were Environmental Health & Life Science students, 17.6% were Business students, 12.1% were Social Science students and 11.1% were Undeclared.
- 7% of all LAC matrics enrolled Fall 2018 did NOT take an LAC course. This number has doubled since the Fall of 2014 when there were only 3.2%.

When looking at **Enrollments**:

- At the non-LAC undergraduate level, 29.5% were Environmental Health & Life Science students, 16.3% were Business students, 8.8% were GO students (conditionally admitted) and 7.1% were Humanities students.
- 62.9 of all students enrolled in a course at LAC were matriculated in an LAC program.
- 34.3% of all students enrolled in a course at LAC were non-LAC matrics. Only 2.7% were non-degree.
- For LAC undergraduate matrics: 46.6% of the course enrollments were in the SBS subject area, 24.1% were in the LAC subject area and 23.8% were in the LOS subject area.
- For LAC graduate matrics: 80.2% of the course enrollments were in the OTH subject area and 19.4% were in the LOS subject area.
- For non-degree undergraduate students: 42.5% of the course enrollments were in the LAC subject area and 30% were in the LOS subject area, and 15% were in the SBS subject area.

- For non-LAC undergraduate matrics: 46.3% of the course enrollments were in the LAC subject area and 19.9% were in the LOS subject area.
- For non-degree graduate students: 85.7% of the course enrollments were in the LOS subject area.

When looking at **Course Credit Hours**:

- 62.9% of all course credit hours at LAC were generated by LAC matrics.
- 34.5% of all course credit hours at LAC were generated by non-LAC matrics. Only 2.7% were non-degree.
- For LAC undergraduate matrics: 48.2% of the course credit hours were in the SBS subject area, 23.8% were in the LAC subject area and 22.6% were in the LOS subject area.
- For LAC graduate matrics: 78.2% of the course credit hours were in the OTH subject area and 21.8% were in the LOS subject area.
- For nonLAC undergraduate matrics: 44.4% of the course credit hours were in the LAC subject area, 20.8% were in the LOS subject area, and 18.2% were in the SBS subject area.
- For non-degree undergraduate students: 26.1% of the total course credit hours were in the LOS subject area, 25.4% of the total course credit hours were in the LAC subject area, and 12.7% were in the SBS subject area.
- For non-degree graduate students: 25.5% of the total course credit hours were in the LOS subject area.

#### LEWISTON AUBURN OVERALL FALL 2018:

- Lewiston Auburn College matrics represents 6.3% of USM's Total Degree-Seeking <sup>1</sup>Headcount and 4.3% of USM's Total Degree-Seeking Student Credit Hours generated at LAC for Fall 2018.
- For Baccalaureate degree-seeking nonLAC matric students, Environmental Health & Life Science majors represent 25.1% of the students and Business majors represent 17.6% of the students.
- For Baccalaureate degree-seeking LAC students, Social & Behavioral Science majors represent 70.3% of the students and Leadership Studies majors represent 25.7% of the students.
- For Master degree-seeking LAC students, Occupational Therapy majors represent 63.1% of the students and Leadership Studies majors represent 36.8% of the students.
- For Baccalaureate degree-seeking students pursuing an LAC Minor, 40% were Early Childhood Studies students, 38.2% were Leadership and Organizational Study students, and 9.3% were Public Health students.

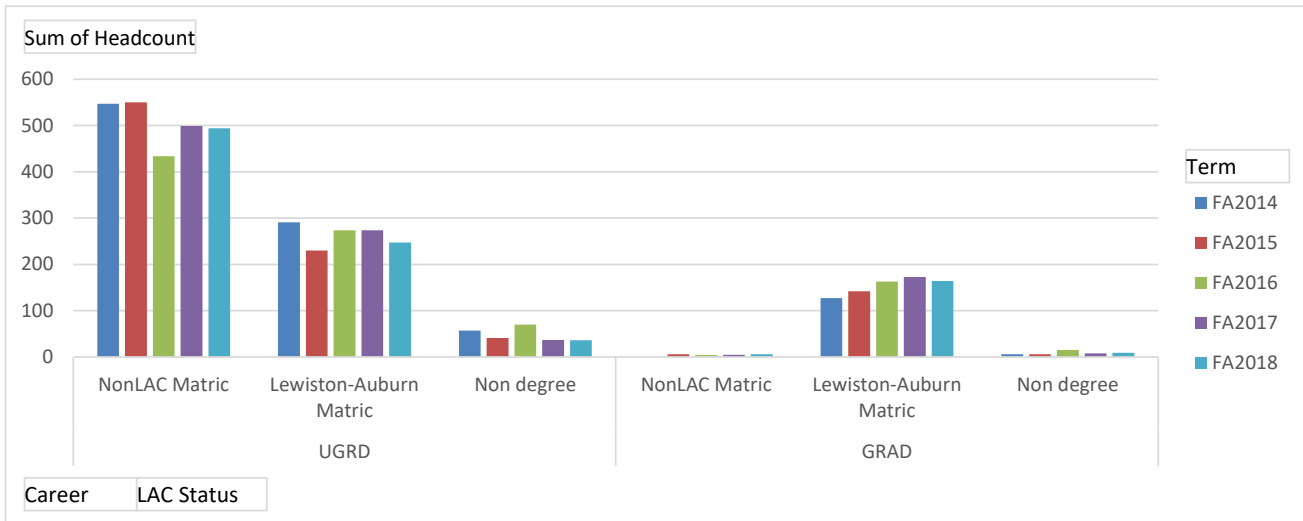

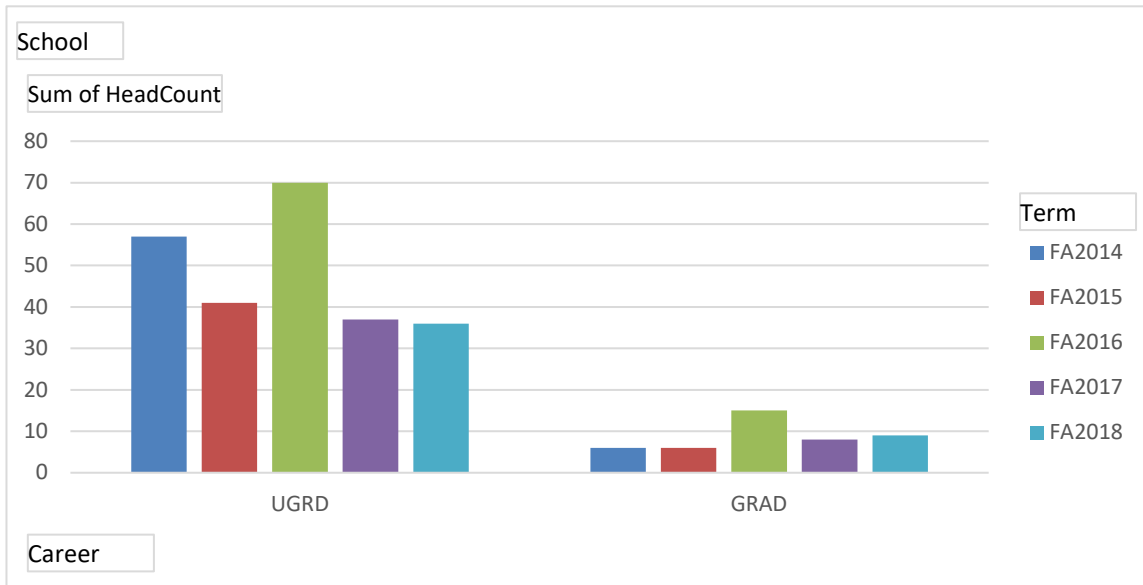

**NonDegree Headcounts by Career taking Courses at LAC**

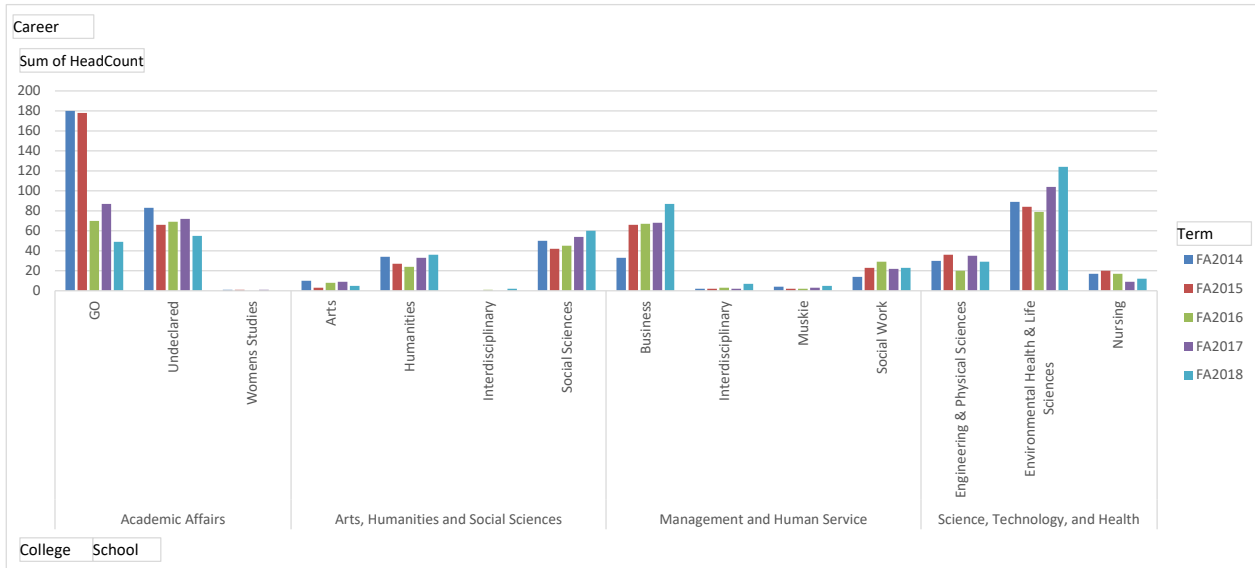

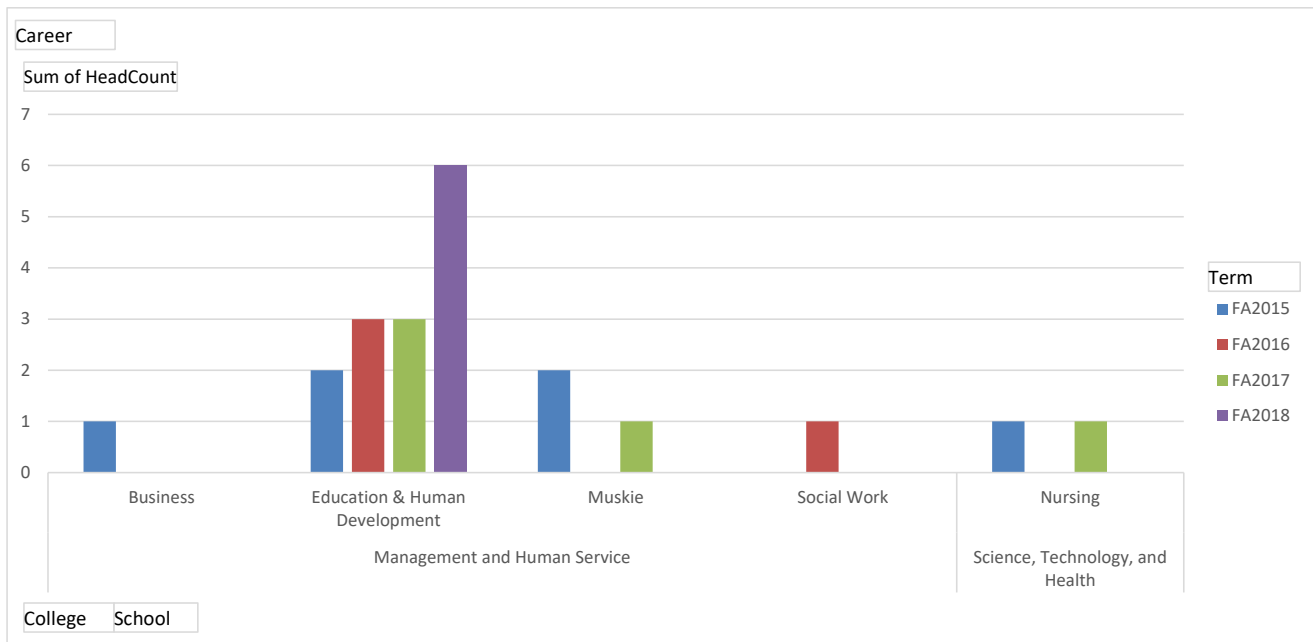

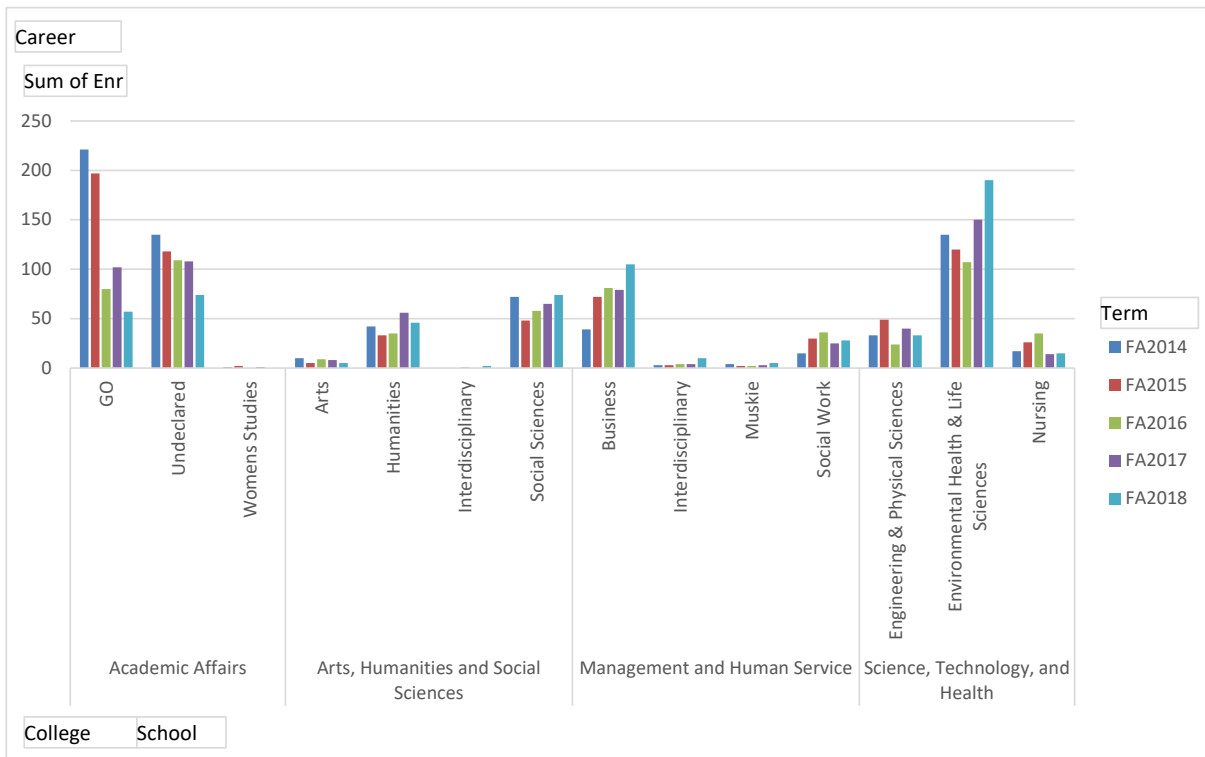

NonLAC Undergraduate Matric Enrollments taking Courses at LAC

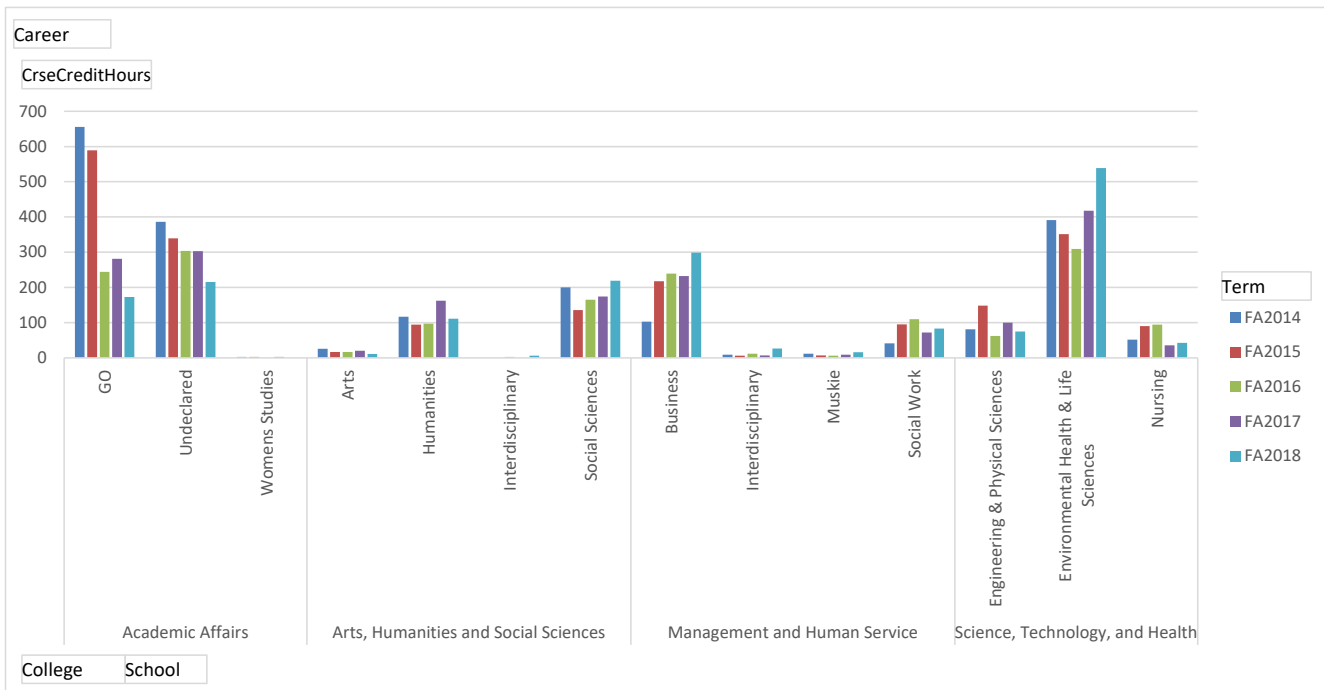
