The GIS Internship (GEO 448/648) allows students to work with GIS outside the Geography-Anthropology Program. Work centers on an applied project conducted with a public agency, private firm, municipality, nonprofit organization, or research unit, using geospatial technology to complete a clearly defined project under the direct supervision of an on-site professional. All GIS internships are overseen by a USM faculty advisor who is directly involved with USM GIS. All equipment and resources needed to complete the internship must be provided on-site by the entity within which the internship is conducted. Students must arrange a regular check-in schedule with the USM faculty advisor to review progress. At the internship's conclusion, students must submit a portfolio including a log book, samples of the work completed, an updated resume, and a written evaluation from the on-site supervisor.
