OUR SORRENTO & ROME TOUR ITINERARY

DAY 1 – BOSTON-INTERMEDIATE STOP-NAPLES: Depart Boston's Logan International Airport on our overnight flight to Naples (*via an intermediate stop*) with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available while in-flight.

DAY 2 – NAPLES~SORRENTO: *Benvenuti in Italia!* Upon arrival at the airport in Naples where our Tour Escort will meet us who will assist with our transfer. Board our private motorcoach for the drive to Sorrento and check-in at the 4-star *Hotel Michelangelo* (or similar). The remainder of the day is at leisure to get acquainted with the hotel and our surroundings. An orientation meeting, with "Welcome Drink", will be held at the hotel prior to dinner. Dinner and overnight at our hotel (D) *Hotel website: www.michelangelohotel.it*

DAY 3 – SORRENTO: After breakfast at the hotel, we will be hosted on a morning walk through the historical center of Sorrento, including a visit to the Museum of Correale which is situated in the 18th century palazzo at the east end of town. Then, we will be taken on a morning tour through the hillsides of Sorrento, where wild roses and camellias surround us. We will visit *La Sorgente*, a picturesque agricultural farm, belonging to the family *Marciano* which is nestled in the Sorrentine hills with a fabulous view of the city of Naples. It is a natural area dotted with orange, lemon, and olive groves and vineyards which have been worked with equipment and methods dating back to the end of the 9th century. Sip on homemade wine, snack on crisp, tender Italian bread (*topped with fresh tomato and a drizzle of olive oil*), and sample the best homemade mozzarella one could imagine! We will experience a demonstration of making mozzarella the old fashioned way. The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure to shop-and-browse in Sorrento. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (BB, L, D)

DAY 4 – ISLE OF CAPRI: Breakfast at our hotel. Today, we will visit the beautiful Isle of Capri! Our full-day excursion includes a round-trip ferry ride, light lunch on Capri, and a guided tour. The town of Capri is very chic with shops, hotels, and restaurants lying along winding streets. The main square, Piazza Umberto, has a pretty white church and several open-air cafés where we can sit and watch the world go by. We will also visit the Augustus Gardens and their magnificent view over the Faraglioni Rocks. Late-afternoon return to the Italian mainland (*via ferry*). Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (BB, L, D)

DAY 5 - AMALFI DRIVE: After breakfast at the hotel, we will be taken on an excursion along one of the most scenic roads in the world – *The Amalfi Drive!* Our first stop will be above Positano, one of Italy's most famous and elegant resorts. We will then continue our drive through the ancient marine republic of Amalfi. There will be some free time to visit the beautiful Cathedral of St. Andrew, explore the town or browse and shop. Light lunch in Scala. Return to Sorrento for dinner and overnight. (BB, L, D)

DAY 6 – POMPEII & NAPLES: Following breakfast, we will visit the "lost city" of Pompeii (*destroyed by the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 AD*) and its excavations. Light lunch in Pompeii. Afterwards, we will tour the city of Naples, visiting the commercial and military port, and the Medieval castle - *Castel dell'Ovo*. Dinner and overnight at our hotel this evening. (BB, L, D)

DAY 7 – ROME: After an early breakfast and check-out at our hotel, we are off to Rome! Stop for a box lunch en route. Arriving in Rome, we will have a panoramic tour of the "Eternal City" including stops at the Colosseum, Trevi Fountain, Piazza Navona and the Pantheon. Late afternoon check-in at the 4-star *Clarhotel* (or similar). Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (BB, BL, D)

DAY 8 – VATICAN CITY: Breakfast at our hotel. In the morning we will visit Vatican City, including a tour of St. Peter's Basilica, the Vatican Museum, and Sistine Chapel. Lunch on our own. The afternoon is at leisure! Dinner with operatic music at a local restaurant this evening. Overnight at our hotel. (BB, D)

DAY 9 – ROME~BOSTON: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will transfer to the Rome Airport to board our flight to Boston (*via possible intermediate stop*) with full meal and beverage as well as stereo headsets, available while in flight. Arrive back in Boston the same day. (BB)

- Round-trip motorcoach transportation to and from Boston's Logan Airport. FREE with a minimum 35 paying passengers. Additional charge if fewer than 35.

- Round trip regularly scheduled flights Boston-intermediate stop-Naples and Rome-possible intermediate stop-Boston with full meal service and beverage service, and headsets for stereo and movies en route.

- Professional Tour Escort who will accompany our group throughout the tour.
- Expert English-speaking tour guides where required.
- All room and meal taxes, and gratuities to bellmen.
