## STEP 1: ENGAGE

1. You'll receive your passport via email this week with your passport number. This number is special to you so don't give it out to anyone.



2. Participate in USM's Passport Approved programs/events. All approved programs will be labeled. Look out for this icon:



## STEP 2: REDEEM

1. Once you're at the approved program/event you'll randomly receive a program code. Go to the web address listed on your passport to redeem your program/event. All you'll need is your Name, Email, Passport ID #, and the provided Event ID Code.

## STEP 3: WIN

1. The more passport approved programs/events you attend the higher your chances of winning.

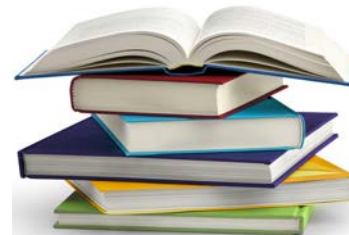
