You must attend the University of Southern Maine for at least six credits within the semester in which the scholarship is disbursed

How to apply:

- 1.) Fill out a UMaine System Scholarship application for each scholarship for which you qualify. You must state why you are eligible for the scholarship.
- 2.) For the “Scholarships for Children of Union Members or Children of Company Employees” listed above, you must obtain the necessary certification for Part II of the application. Certification requirements are listed in the scholarship descriptions.
- 3.) If financial need is a scholarship requirement, you must file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- 4.) Minimum GPA of 2.0 is required for all scholarships. Note that some scholarships have additional academic requirements.
- 5.) If an essay is required, please attach on a separate page
