- Two (2) letters of recommendation from individuals other than a family member that clearly demonstrate an interest in the field of building construction. If possible, at least one of these letters should come from a previous employer.
- Submit proof of good academic standing (*Transcript*).

For priority consideration, please submit your completed scholarship application by **May 15th**.
