**Requirements:** Successful completion of the EMCC Associate in Applied Science in Nursing, passage of the NCLEX-RN exam, submission of the completed admission application, transcripts, and other supporting materials. For coursework to transfer to the University of Southern Maine, a student must earn a grade of C- or better. Students must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5 to graduate from the Bachelor of Science in Nursing program. For all baccalaureate degrees at the University, a minimum of 30 credit hours, including at least 9 credit hours in the major field at the 200-level or above, must be completed at the University of Southern Maine.
