Requirements

Successful completion of the SMCC Associate in Science in Education, submission of a completed admission application (if necessary), transcripts, and other supporting materials. The minimum academic requirements to be a student in good standing in the Elementary Teacher Education Pathway at USM are as follows.

- A grade of B- or better in all professional education coursework.
- A grade of C or better in disciplinary concentration courses and courses required for the area of teacher certification.
- An overall GPA of 3.0 or better.

Student must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 to graduate from the University of Southern Maine with a BS in Elementary Education. For all baccalaureate degrees at the University, a minimum of 30 credit hours, including at least 9 credit hours in the major field at the 200-level or above, must be completed at the University of Southern Maine.
